Nick Owen is currently the main presenter on the regional news programme **BBC Midlands Today**.

Nick has worked in regional and national TV since the late Seventies. He came to national prominence in 1983 as one of the first faces to appear on breakfast television in Britain.

Nick moved to BBC One to co-present the popular **Good Morning with Anne and Nick** from 1992 until May 1996 – a total of 600 programmes.
